

# ECH Henley Beach Bus Trip Schedule – February 2020

6 February	The Barossa Valley & Maggie Beer's Farm Shop	Travel to the picturesque Barossa Valley and visit Chateau Barossa for a guided tour. Head to Maggie Beer's famous farm shop for a free cooking demonstration and browse her many products. Lunch will follow before returning home.
20 February	Discover the Fleurieu	Enjoy a scenic drive to Goolwa and visit the Signal Point Gallery to view the many artworks and exhibitions by contemporary artists from across the region. Take a stroll through the township of Goolwa before heading to Hindmarsh Island. Lunch will follow at the Hotel Elliot.

## Cost and Eligibility Criteria

Cost is \$35 per person and includes snacks, lunch and any applicable entrance fees.

\*To access the subsidised rate of \$35, you will need a referral from My Aged Care. To access a My Aged Care referral please contact ECH on 1300 275 324. If you do not wish to obtain a referral please discuss with staff about 'out-of-pocket' costs.

All participants are required to complete an ECH assessment prior to booking or attending. An ECH staff member will contact you to book in the assessment once a My Aged Care referral is received.

## Changes or Cancellations

ECH applies a strict booking and cancellation policy. Bookings and cancellations are essential for all bus trips. Notification of cancellation is required by 4pm the day prior to the scheduled trip. Where timely cancellations are not received, the full price may be applied, except in the circumstance of an unplanned hospitalisation or a medical emergency.

## Departure and arrival time

Bus trips depart from 1-11 Laidlaw St, Henley Beach at 9.00am and will return to the same location at 4.00pm. Please arrive 15 minutes prior to departure to ensure the bus leaves on time.
